Basic rules

"Stop" sign



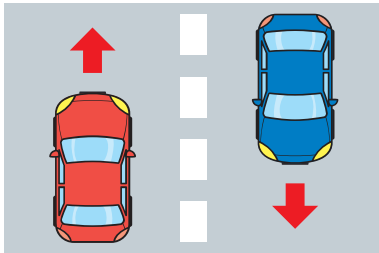
You must stop the vehicle completely and look both ways to ensure it is safe.

Speed limit



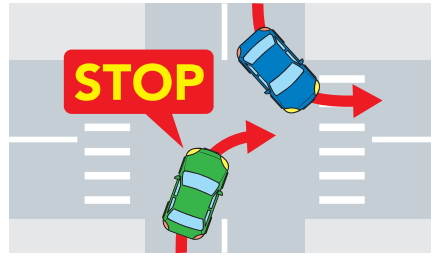
Legal speed limit is 60km/h on general roads and 100km/h on expressways.

Keep left



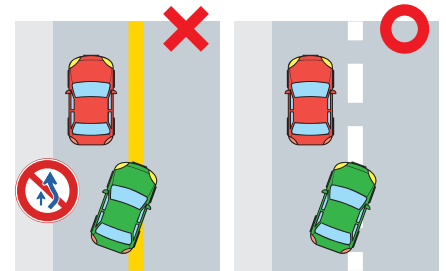
All vehicles must drive on the left-hand side of the road.

Stop before turning right



Watch out for cars in the opposite lane when turning right at an intersection.

No-passing zones



Passing is forbidden in zones with a yellow center line.

Seatbelts and child car seats



All passengers must wear seatbelts and children under six years of age must be seated in child seats.

Never drive after drinking



The driver under the influence of alcohol and passengers who encourage to drink will be penalized.

Never use a mobile phone while driving



There are penalties for talking on a handheld mobile phone and for focusing on a screen while driving.

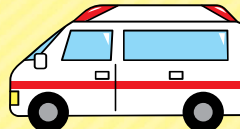

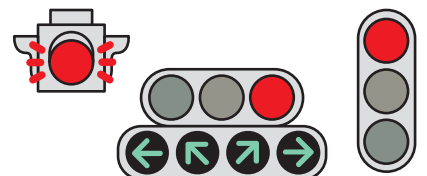

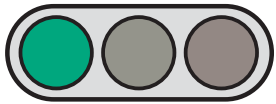

Various types of traffic lights



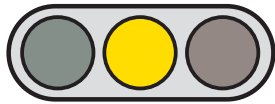
Traffic lights

Green lights



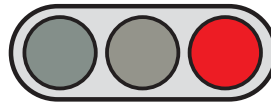
You may proceed.

Yellow lights

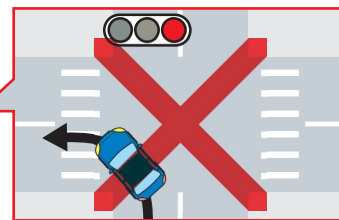


Do not start to proceed.

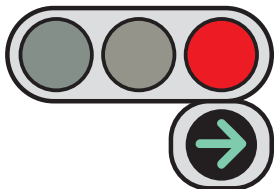
Red lights



Do not proceed.

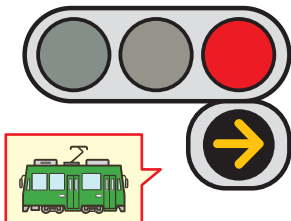


Green arrow



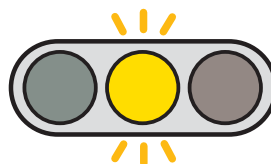
You can proceed in the direction of green arrow.

Yellow Arrow



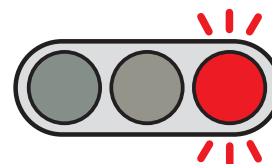
Do not proceed in the direction of yellow arrow as they are only for tram.

Blinking yellow lights



You have to caution for pedestrians and vehicles coming from the right or the left.

Blinking red lights



You must stop the vehicle completely and look both ways to ensure it is safe.

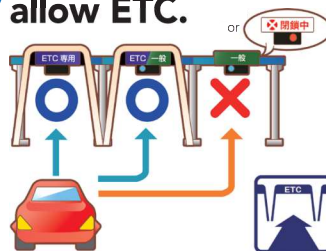


How to use ETC

1 Insert your ETC card all the way into the slot.



2 Check which lanes allow ETC.



3 Do not exceed 20km/L when entering the lane.
